- Phone interviews will be conducted from <u>February 1-3, 2023</u>.
- Finalists will be notified on or before February 10, and awards offered to those not advancing to the Finals.
- Finalist interviews will be conducted on campus February 24, 2023.
- Final awards will be offered by March 3, 2023.
