Scholarship Process and Schedule

- The scholarship application process will open on October 1, 2025 with a deadline for all submissions of midnight (CST) on December 15, 2025.
- Semi-finalists will be notified on January 13, 2026.
- Phone interviews will be conducted from January 20-23, 2026.
- Finalists will be notified on or before January 27, 2026 and awards offered to those not advancing to the Finals.
- Finalist interviews will be conducted on campus February 6, 2026.
- Final awards will be offered by March 1, 2026.
